ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. The Maintenance Technician II maintains and repairs water, water reclamation, and wastewater systems, facilities, and equipment; including pump systems, pressure reducing stations, valves, cla-vals, and related appurtenances and structures; performs landscaping and grounds maintenance duties; performs construction and maintenance work on District buildings and facilities as assigned.
2. Repair and maintains water, water reclamation, and pressure reducing/sustaining stations, cla-vals, and pump stations; sewer systems such as lift stations, pressure lines, and related structures.
3. Assist in the repair of equipment within the water reclamation facilities; loads and unloads trucks; cleans up work sites upon completion of job; operates and assists in the preventive maintenance on pumps, repairs valves and related water pump station, lift station, and reclamation plant equipment; reads and interprets plans, maps, and prints.
4. Operate and maintains a wide variety of hand and power tools related to the work including spaders, tampers, breaking guns, jack hammers, concrete saws, etc.
5. The Maintenance Technician II operates a variety of trucks and equipment; inspects vehicles and performs minor maintenance; reports needed repairs;
6. Estimate and secures tools, materials, and equipment necessary to complete assignments; requests parts and supplies as necessary.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Knowledge of:

- The equipment, techniques, and procedures involved in the maintenance and repair of potable water pump stations, altitude control valves, pressure reducing/sustaining stations, water reclamation plant, sewer lift stations, and related facilities and equipment.
- Related laws, ordinances, rules, regulations, policies, and procedures; codes and regulations applicable to the work.
- Operation and maintenance of a wide variety of hand and power tools and equipment common to the work performed.

- Safe work methods and safety regulations pertaining to the work.
- Basic computerized record keeping applications.
- Principles and practices of electrical and confined space protection.

Ability to:

- Be on-call on a rotational basis and work outside of regular work hours as necessary, including weekends and holidays.
- Perform a variety of repair, and maintenance tasks.
- Work under routine and emergency conditions, sometimes in severe weather.
- Perform a wide variety of physically strenuous tasks.
- Enter data into computer system and maintain records.
- Read, interpret, and understand blueprints and construction drawings.
- Maintain and repair equipment and tools.
- Work with hand tools and perform a variety of repair and maintenance tasks.
- Exercise independent judgment and initiative without close supervision.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

High school graduation or equivalent, four years of mechanical maintenance work experience.

Experience with mechanical and electrical systems preferred.

Must possess a D certification in Water or D certification in Wastewater, or the ability to obtain within 18 months of hire.

CMRT/CMRP or other Maintenance Proficiency Certifications a plus, or the ability to obtain within 18 months of hire.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Must possess valid Colorado Driver's license. If applicant has a valid out of state license they must obtain a valid Colorado license within 30 days of hire or their employment may be terminated.
- Must present a report from the Colorado Division of Motor Vehicles or if out of State an equivalent report that indicates a driving record acceptable to the Authority in obtaining insurance coverage. Using of any type of tobacco product is not allowed on company property or in company vehicles at any time.
